Clinical Neurosciences 2012: Individualized Psychiatric Treatment: Genes, Gender & Culture

Course Overview

One of the great challenges in Psychiatry is how to tailor the treatment of the patient so they will have the best response possible. The task of individualizing a patient's treatment requires skills in assessment, diagnosis, understanding the stages of the illness and its course as well as the research evidence of best practices. This year's talks will include looking at schizophrenia through a cultural lens, staging first episode psychosis, and ethnic variables in the treatment of mood and psychotic disorders.
