**2021 BILL AND MARILYN WEBBER LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD**

*The Bill and Marilyn Webber Lifetime Achievement Award recognizes extraordinary members of the Faculty of Medicine who have sustained distinguished careers at UBC. All nominees should have demonstrated a strong commitment to living the Faculty of Medicine values of respect, integrity, compassion, collaboration, equity.*

The Bill and Marilyn Webber Lifetime Achievement Award is made in recognition of sustained scholarly achievement in the areas of research, teaching and/or service as defined by the guidelines for promotion in the Guide to Promotion & Tenure Procedures at UBC.

Nominations must be made by any three Professors, Professors Emeritus/Emerita, Professors of Teaching, Clinical Professors or Clinical Professors Emeritus/Emerita in the Faculty of Medicine.

**ELIGIBILITY**

- Nominees must be at the rank of Professor, Professor Emeritus/Emerita, Professor of Teaching, Clinical Professor or Clinical Professor Emeritus/Emerita
- Nominees must have held an appointment at UBC for at least 15 years.
- At the time of nomination, the nominee must be an active member of the UBC Faculty of Medicine, which includes all [distributed sites, departments, schools, and other academic units](#)

Provided that the nomination package is updated every year, nominations will stand for three consecutive years. It is the nominators' responsibility to keep a nomination current. The Adjudication Committee will resolve questions concerning eligibility. An award may not be granted every year. The identities of the nominees will not be made public unless they win the award. Decisions made by the Adjudication Committee are final and may not be appealed. Posthumous awards will not be made. Nominators should not expect members of the Dean's Office or Adjudication Committee staff to assist with the preparation of a nomination beyond general advice concerning the regulations and proper forms to use.

**SELECTION CRITERIA**

Nominations will be evaluated against the following criteria:

- Evidence of distinguished scholarly activities sustained throughout the career.
- Evidence of the nominee's level of national and international recognition.
- Evidence that that nominee has, and continues to exhibit and promote commitment to the vision, mission and values of their team, unit and the Faculty of Medicine.
